SUPPORTING NOTES FOR APPLICATION FORM Association of Pet Dog Trainers Ireland Membership

Please read the following notes carefully prior to completion of the application form.

The Association of Pet Dog Trainers Ireland offers two levels of membership:

1. Professional Membership.

Applicants for Professional Membership should be currently offering services in positive dog training and/or behaviour modification and/or consultation. Applicants for Professional Membership are required to complete a three part assessment including written, practical and oral assessment for which there is a one off additional fee of £150. Successful applicants, having signed their adherence to the Code of Practice, will be issued with a membership number and welcomed into the Association as a positive, dog friendly dog trainer. Members will be obliged to conduct their professional services in line with the Code of Practice. Should an applicant be deemed currently not ready for professional membership they shall be given a refund of £100. Professional membership applicants will be contacted regarding the date for their assessment.

2. Student Membership.

This membership is specifically for individuals that are studying in the area of canine behaviour and training, either full time, part time or through correspondence in Ireland or the UK. Some students will be working towards their application for Professional Membership on completion of their studies. Confirmation of student status or further details of the course being studied may be requested.

The following table outlines the membership types, annual membership fees and what members can expect to receive for their membership

Membership Type	Fee	Membership Entitlements
Professional	€60 per annum (excluding initial membership assessment of €150)	Full years membership, access to discussion forum, reduced fees to all APDT Ireland events and seminars, APDTIre membership number and use of Logo, Newsletter
Student	€20 per annum	As above excluding membership number and use of logo.

Membership renewal will be due annually by 31st March with a 10% penalty for payment received later than the renewal date. Members who do not make their renewal by 31st May will be deemed to have terminated their membership. If reapplying for membership more than one year after such termination, the person must reapply for membership as a new applicant.

New Professional Members are given a 50% discount on their initial years membership fee after payment of assessment fees and successful assessment.

Current membership fees must be made payable in a cheque or bank draft to 'APDT Ireland' and sent with membership application form to:
